- ✓ Ensure preventive and corrective maintenance of high-tech industrial equipment (fault diagnosis, preventive and/or corrective actions, disassembly, installation of new equipment)
- ✓ Manage the maintenance of buildings and facilities (HVAC, electrical systems, fluids), while adhering to OSHA standards and group quality.
- ✓ Ensure the security, reliability, and operational continuity of the site.
- ✓ Carry out rigorous reporting, analyze failures, and contribute to continuous improvement.
- ✓ Identify and monitor faults and machine indicators (uptime, MTBF, drift...)
- ✓ Draft preventive maintenance procedures based on the complexity of the intervention under the supervision of a more experienced technician.
- ✓ Fill out intervention tracking documents by recording and reporting incidents.
- ✓ Identify and communicate needs (spare parts and machine consumables).
- ✓ Follow maintenance protocols to ensure the safety of maintenance operations in collaboration with the HSE, Method, and Quality teams.
- ✓ The technician strictly adheres to OSHA standards and participates in risk prevention just like any other employee.

Required qualities: The position requires technical versatility (electrotechnics, mechanics, automation), adaptability to technological changes, and active participation in continuous improvement.
